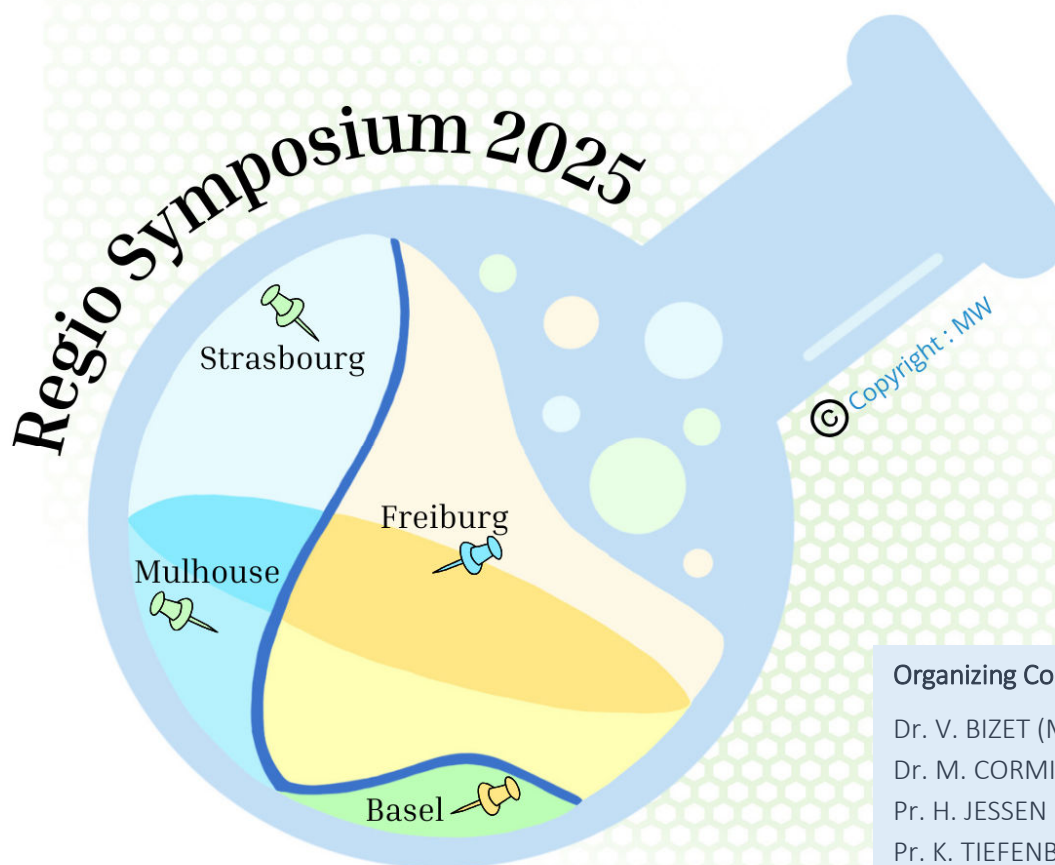

The participants will have the opportunity to give a short lecture to present their research. There will be **12 short talks** (format: 12 minutes research presentation, 3 minutes question & answers). A selection will be done based on the abstract, which must be submitted before July 15<sup>th</sup> 2025 on the website ([regiosymposium.sciencesconf.org](https://regiosymposium.sciencesconf.org)) using the template provided on the website. Results will be announced before July 25th.

A video projector will be used during this session. For a smooth organization, please ask the organizers to upload your slides on the dedicated computer before the session where your presentation is scheduled.
